
22. DELEGATION OF DUTIES BY THE TRUSTEES



No Trustees shall be liable for any loss not attributed to his/her own dishonesty or of commission by him/her of an act amounting to a breach of Trust, and in particular he/she shall not be made liable for failure to take and proceedings against any co-trustee for any breach or alleged breach of trust committed by co-trustee.

- 26) Every Trustee shall be indemnified out of the funds of the Trust in respect of any loss arising from (or) contingent upon any investment made of any of the monies of the fund unless such loss have been occasioned by his/her own negligence and also every Trustee shall be indemnified out of the fund against all proceedings, suits claims, costs damages and expenses occasioned by any claim in connection with the Trust and in the execution of the Trusts created by these presents (or) in the exercise of any powers, authorities (or) discretion vested in them pursuant to these presents.

27) CONVENANT BY THE TRUSTEES

28. The Trustees shall have power to frame rules for the proper conduct of the affairs of the Trust as well as of any of its institutions but not inconsistent with the provisions here of.
29. Should any controversy (or) doubt arise regarding the purport meaning (or) construction of these presents (or) any other matter relating to the Trust the decision of the president in respect of the same shall be final and binding.

DISSOLUTION OF THE TRUST

30) Should at any time all the Trustees for the time being un-animously decide that the purpose for which the Trust has been created are no longer being fulfilled (or) the necessity for the same has ceased to exist on any account (or) that no useful purpose is served by continuing the Trust then and in that event the Trustees shall be at liberty to dissolve the Trust and the assets that remain after the satisfaction of all the debts and liabilities of the Trust shall be transferred to some other public charitable institution, society (or) body to be determined unanimously by the Trustees for the time being.
